So here we go! After the Resurrection, things started moving quickly for the disciples...so quickly that maybe their heads were spinning! On the one hand, they

often felt compelled to lay low for fear of those who had called for the death of Jesus. On the other hand, witnesses were reporting encounters with the risen Jesus, and then the disciples saw him for themselves. All that Jesus had been telling them was suddenly very, very real. So, what did they do? They followed a combination of day-to-day tasks like fishing (possibly to calm their nerves?) and preparation, just as he had instructed. They elected Matthias to take the place of Judas, and spoke about Jesus in the local synagogues, all while they waited for the Holy Spirit to come as promised. They were preparing to know, and live, the answer to Q1 of the *Heidelberg Catechism*. Please join us as we prepare to do the same, worshiping the risen Lord.


